DIVISIONS:

<u>Division</u>	<u>Age as of January 1, 2016</u>
Lead In	0-6
Ride Alone	0-6
Buckaroo	7-10
Junior	11-13
Senior	14-17
Adult	18 & over

POINT ACCUMULATION:

1st place in each event will receive 15 points.

2nd place in each event will receive 10 points.

3rd place in each event will receive 5 points.

No time will be given for a broken pattern

*Participation points are awarded to those who participate in all 3 events.

*Points will be tallied up and posted to the Facebook page usually within a week of event.

SAFETY RULES:

1. NO TENNIS SHOES allowed for any riding participant – **heeled boots are required.** Riding helmets are not required, but are encouraged. Long pants are required!
2. Gates to the arena will be closed while the rider is in the arena completing the pattern, and alley way needs to remain clear at all times.
3. Horses are to be ridden no faster than a walk outside of the arena.
4. No riding double on arena grounds or in the arena, unless required for a timed event.
5. HRC is not responsible for accidents to horses or riders.

GENERAL RULES:

1. Each Playday will start on time with a prayer, National Anthem with American Flag and a grand entry. If you want to warm your horse up be sure to arrive early as arena will be cleared 5 minutes before start time.
2. COGGINS PAPERS ARE REQUIRED ON EACH HORSE HAULED TO PLAYDAYS, AND WILL BE CHECKED. (Exception being the Lorene Fleshman Get Acquainted Day when the coggins clinic is held.)
3. Lorene Fleshman Get Acquainted Day does not count for Playday attendance or points.
4. Must be a paid HRC member for points to accumulate for a year end prize. Minors must have a parent or guardian that is a Roundup Club member for points to accumulate.
5. May participate in 1 Playday before deciding to become a paid HRC member, but must join HRC to attend anymore Playdays. Must be a member prior to start of Play day events for that days points to count.
6. Three (3) points total will be given for attendance and participation. Sign-in each Playday is required for points, including attendance points, to count towards final score. **ALL PARTICIPANTS OR THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENSURING THEY ARE SIGNED IN AT EVERY PLAYDAY.**

7. Must participate in at least 3 Playdays with timed events, work at least 1 Playday Work Day, be an HRC paid member, **and** attend the HRC Year End Awards Banquet in order to get a participation trophy. All other year end prizes to be determined based on Playday fund availability.
8. NO CELL PHONES ALLOWED on horseback during warm-up, events, and back awaiting area.
9. NO DOGS ALLOWED anywhere on arena ground (parking area, spectator stands or in the arena)
10. NO BABYSITTING, be responsible for your own child. **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CHILDREN UNATTENDED WHETHER IT IS IN THE STANDS OR ON HORSE BACK.**
11. NO Tank Tops, please dress responsibly.
12. **KEEP ARENA AND STAND CLEAN!!! YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PICKING UP AND DISPOSING OF YOUR OWN TRASH!**
13. **No Smoking in the stands or arena.** If you want to smoke please go to a designed area for the safety of others around you.

EVENT RULES:

Playday events will consist of barrels and poles; the 3rd event is determined at each Playday. Barrels and poles will follow HRC Play Day event rules:

1. Timers will be used and re-runs will be allowed in the event of technical error.
2. 4 poles will be used for Lead In
3. Hats/Helmets are not required, but helmets are recommended for those under 5.
4. Barrel & Pole placement will be stepped off as close as possible to AQHA dimensions.
5. +5 will be added to the time of anyone being lead in that is not in the lead in division and for each barrel or pole knocked over.
